***Conway's sales tax rate increased from 1.75% to 2.125% April 1, 2018

Beginning in April 2018, the Conway sales tax collections are reduced by 3/8% to account for the sales tax increase when estimating the retail sales.

Sales tax collections do not match monthly municipality receipts exactly because there is a two month delay in distributions, and the state receives approximately three percent for administration.
